Economically and ecologically sustainable construction is proving to be a long-time favorite in the industry. As part of a study by dena (German Energy Agency) and rudena (Russian-German Energy Agency) in preparation for the Winter Olympics 2014 in Sochi, Drees & Sommer analyzed how the primary energy demand for the Olympic buildings could be reduced by up to 70 percent compared to average Russian properties. In Austria, Drees & Sommer has been commissioned to certify the new Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration building with the DGNB certificate of the Austrian Sustainable Building Council (ÖGNB). Drees & Sommer is also an international player in commercial property, with major international projects in Germany, Belgium and Turkey.

On March 18, Thomas Jaißle, Managing Director of Drees & Sommer Stuttgart, will give a presentation entitled 'How to get established buildings fit for international markets' at the City of Stuttgart booth (H4.24). In this context, he will show opportunities for sustainable economic and ecological optimization of properties.
